

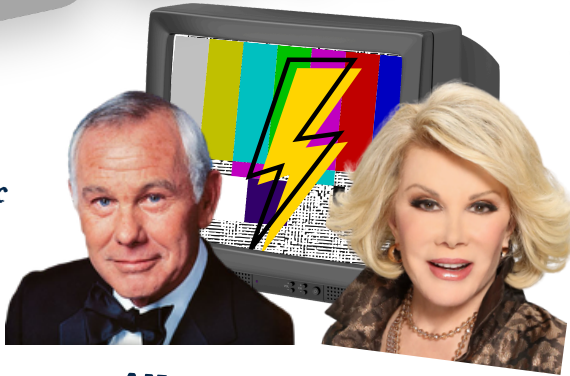

liftoff.

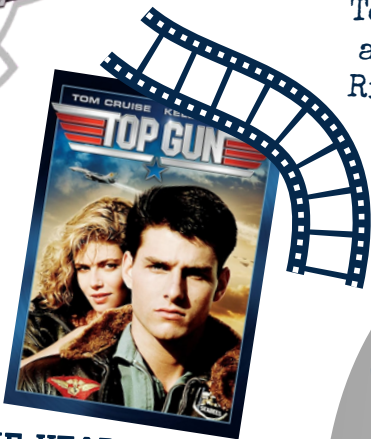

1986 was .86 cents !!!

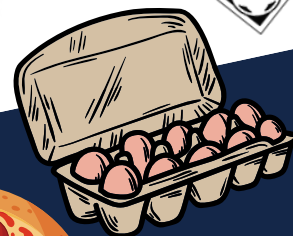
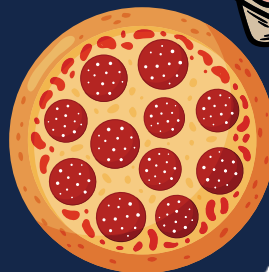


CAN OF COKE:

WHAT DID THINGS COST?

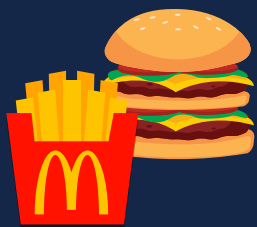
A PIZZA:

Only cost about \$2.00

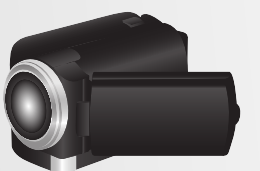


CANDY BAR:
